Bins, boxes, trays, and a handy message board are crafts-room BFFs. Use them in assorted sizes to store, sort, and corral all those little tools and necessities—including scissors, envelopes, labels, and stationery, as well as buttons, beads, and decorative tapes.

**crafts room** Designer Jeannie Fraise wanted to bring parent and child together in her studio crafts room to take part in the creative process. The dark, dismal basement room needed a lot of work, though. "I knew I could use color and graphic patterns to warm up this space and make it functional and inviting," says Fraise. Black-and-white patterns ground the room, while pink, green, and other bright fabrics by Raoul Textiles add warmth. The cozy built-in nook provides plenty of seating around a custom quatrefoil-shaped table by Oomph. To give the illusion of a larger window, Fraise installed a red shade system from Conrad across the entire rear wall.
